# WHAT IS TU B'SHEVAT?

There are four occasions in the Jewish calendar that we call Rosh Hashanah:

- The first of Nisan—the Rosh Hashanah for months;
- The first of Elul—the Rosh Hashanah for animal tithe accounting;
- The first of Tishrei—the Rosh Hashanah for the new year;
- The fifteenth of Shevat—the Rosh Hashanah for fruit tithe accounting.

As we are commanded to tithe our fruit trees, we need a period of accounting in order to figure out how much we owe. This fiscal year begins on the 15<sup>th</sup> of Shevat (**this year, 15 Shevat starts sundown Sunday, January 20<sup>th</sup> and ends sundown Monday, January 21<sup>st</sup>**). Many people have the custom to eat from the fruits for which Eretz Yisroel is praised: Figs, dates, olives, pomegranates and grapes. Due to the fact that Tu B'shevat is a quasi-holiday, Tachanun is omitted in the prayer service.
