The Mikvah itself will be functional for Shabbos and Yom Tov, and if necessary, during the week of Chol Hamoed. It should be fully operational by Monday, April 29th.

What this means is that until April 29th all of your preparations will need to be done at home and only the Tevillah can be done in the Mikvah.

We are excited that in less than one week we will resume normal Mikvah operations. Please spread the word – THE MIKVAH IS BACK!
